Delivery Schedule Advisements:

1. Although Delivery Dates by County have been identified, the production of the Maryland Statewide Ortho Program has been based on Production Blocks. The production block boundaries encompass multiple counties and were designed to provide economy of scale efficiencies. Each County will be delivered upon completion of all tiles within their relevant production blocks.
2. The production schedule for Allegany and Garrett has been established using assumptions made regarding our experience with the DTM information provided for Washington County. Additional edits to the DTM in Washington County were required in order to meet the specifications of the Maryland Statewide Ortho Program. If additional edits beyond are assumptions made as of this schedule are required for Allegany and Garrett, schedule slippage may occur for these counties.
3. Garrett County DTM data is still unavailable at the time of this report. AXIS has assumed this information will be provided in a time frame which allows us to maintain the production schedules stated herein.
4. Accuracy of Worcester and Somerset DTM information is unknown at the time of this report. Schedule slippage may occur if addition edits are required beyond our assumptions.
5. AXIS has made scheduling assumptions for the QA Contractor. AXIS assumes the State will ensure the QA schedule is met in order to fulfill final deliveries. Having a great working relationship with the QA Contractor, AXIS believes the assumptions made as of this report are fairly accurate.
